EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS: The Honorable Sandra Day O'Connor passed away on Friday, December 1,

2023; and

WHEREAS: Appointed by President Ronald Reagan in 1981, Justice O'Connor was the

first woman to serve as an Associate Justice of the United States Supreme

Court; and

WHEREAS: In 2009, Justice O'Connor was awarded a Presidential Medal of Freedom

due to her lifetime of dedicated public service to her state and our country;

and

WHEREAS: In accordance with United States Flag Code, it is fitting and proper to fly the

flag of the United States of America at half-staff in honor or and to recognize

the passing of an Associate Justice of the United States Supreme Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be

flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds from this date until the

date of Justice O'Connor's interment.
