A PROCLAMATION

AMNIOTIC FLUID EMBOLISM AWARENESS DAY

- **WHEREAS:** Amniotic fluid embolism (AFE) is a catastrophic complication of pregnancy in which amniotic fluid, fetal cells, hair, or other debris enters into the maternal pulmonary circulation, causing cardiovascular collapse; and
- **WHEREAS**: Amniotic fluid embolism (AFE) is very rare and very difficult to diagnose because the symptoms can be similar to other serious complications during childbirth; and
- **WHEREAS:** The AFE Foundation, working in collaboration with key stakeholders in Georgia, provides meaningful education and life-saving skills to properly prepare healthcare providers to treat and manage patients and ultimately save lives; and

WHEREAS: Awareness of AFE and further research will promote understanding of the disorder, expanded treatment options, and an increase in the number of lives saved; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 27, 2023, as AMERICAN HEART MONTH in Georgia.
