## **A PROCLAMATION**

## APPRENTICESHIP WEEK

WHEREAS:

Georgia's skilled and trained workforce has been integral to helping Georgia be the best state in the nation for business for a decade running; and

WHEREAS:

Apprenticeships are an important workforce development tool that both connects Georgians to quality career pathways, and transforms Georgians into highly skilled talents that advance and grow Georgia's economy, lifting

households and communities into greater prosperity; and

WHEREAS:

The Technical College System of Georgia, through Apprentice Georgia, has supported hundreds of apprenticeships in industry and globally leading quality jobs; and

WHEREAS:

The State of Georgia's investment into the High Demand Career Initiatives (HDCI) program has brought the expansion and creation of Registered Apprenticeships to businesses and communities of all sizes throughout the state; and

WHEREAS:

Georgia's Technical Colleges serve as Registered Apprenticeship Sponsors, providing apprenticeship access statewide; and

WHEREAS:

This year, the State Workforce Development Board established Georgia's first statewide apprenticeship advisory body to further maximize the impact of Registered Apprenticeships on small to medium-sized businesses and individuals with barriers; and

WHEREAS:

Registered Apprenticeships continue to build the state's next generation of talent, ensuring that Georgia continues to provide local pathways to economic opportunity for all Georgians; now

THEREFORE:

I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim November 13<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023 as APPRENTICESHIP WEEK in Georgia.
