## **A PROCLAMATION**

## **BLOOD DONATION DAY**

WHEREAS:	The State of Georgia is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting the state; and
WHEREAS:	A sufficient blood supply is necessary for public health both locally and nationally, and hospitals and medical centers need a readily available supply for our residents and visitors; and
WHEREAS:	One blood donation can help save more than one life, and although most of the U.S. population is eligible to donate blood, only about 3% do; and
WHEREAS:	Georgia is home to many organizations committed to raising awareness about the importance of blood donation, including the American Red Cross and others; and
WHEREAS:	The Georgia Blood Donation Day reminds Georgians of the need to replenish blood supplies across the state through donation and community awareness; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby September 4, 2023, as BLOOD DONATION DAY in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 30<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Three.
