WHEREAS:	Cancer registrars evaluate the success of specific treatments and identify, plan, and implement cancer prevention and screening programs; and
WHEREAS:	Data collected by cancer registrars is used by physicians to monitor treatment and continue to care for patients; and
WHEREAS:	Data collected by cancer registrars includes patient demographics, anatomic cancer sites, stages of diseases, treatments, and lifetime follow-ups. This data is also valuable to epidemiologists as they determine the cancer burden throughout Georgia and the nation; and
WHEREAS:	Cancer registrars throughout our state are committed to promoting the latest medical advances in the diagnosis and treatment of this devastating disease; and
WHEREAS:	Cancer Registrars Week recognizes the contributions and advances that professional cancer registrars make in the field of allied health across our state; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 3- 7, 2023, as CANCER REGISTRARS WEEK in Georgia.
