A PROCLAMATION

CAR WASH DAY

WHEREAS:	Vehicles are significant investments and require regular care and service to ensure optimal durability; and
WHEREAS:	Vehicles are often washed once every three weeks to remove dirt, dust, and grime and avoid damage from salt and other substances; and
WHEREAS:	Motorists who are commuters or frequent travelers may require additional car care due to more recurrent exposure to both road debris and natural elements; and
WHEREAS:	The owners and operators of car wash and car care facilities throughout the State of Georgia have demonstrated standards of professionalism by retaining the proper credentials, providing quality services, and appropriately addressing the needs of their customers; and
WHEREAS:	Car Wash Day lends Georgia the opportunity to raise awareness of the importance of regular car washes among vehicle owners and reminds Georgians that regular, proper vehicle care is crucial to the longevity of vehicles; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim July 14, 2023, as CAR WASH DAY in Georgia.
