A PROCLAMATION

CHRISTIAN HERITAGE WEEK

WHEREAS:	The Preamble to the Constitution of the State of Georgia states that, "To perpetuate the principles of free government, ensure justice to all, preserve peace, promote the interest and happiness of the citizen and of the family, and transmit to posterity the enjoyment of liberty, we the people of Georgia, relying upon the protection and guidance of Almighty God, do ordain and establish this Constitution."; and
WHEREAS:	Benjamin Franklin, at the Constitutional Convention in 1787 stated: "And if a sparrow cannot fall to the ground without His notice, is it probable that an empire can rise without His aid? We have been assured, Sir, in the sacred writings that except the Lord build the house, they labor in vain that build it. " (Psalm 127:1); and
WHEREAS:	George Washington enunciated: "animated alone by the pure spirit of Christianity, and conducting ourselves as the faithful subjects of our free government, we may enjoy every temporal and spiritual felicity"; and
WHEREAS:	Thomas Jefferson, the author of the Declaration of Independence, wrote: "Can the liberties of a nation be secure when we have removed the conviction that these liberties are the gift of God?;" and
WHEREAS:	James Madison, the father of the U.S. Constitution, advocated "the diffusion of the light of Christianity in our nation" in his Memorial and Remonstrance
WHEREAS:	These, and many other great men and women throughout America's history, were statesmen of high caliber and integrity who expressed their faith; now; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 16- 22, 2023, as CHRISTIAN HERITAGE WEEK in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 10th day of April in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Three.
