A PROCLAMATION

COMMUNITY SUPERVISION WEEK

- WHEREAS:** Community corrections is an essential part of the justice system in the State of Georgia; and
- WHEREAS:** Community corrections professionals are trained to provide services and referrals for offenders and are also responsible for supervising adult and juvenile offenders in the community; and
- WHEREAS:** In addition to working with offenders, community corrections professionals also work in partnership with community agencies and groups, as well as providing services, support, and protection for victims. In doing so, they promote prevention, intervention, and advocacy; and
- WHEREAS:** Community corrections professionals uphold the law with dignity, while recognizing the right of the public to be safe guarded from criminal activity; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Department of Community Supervision is nationally recognized for their contributions to the community corrections profession which reflect positively on our State; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim July 16-23, 2023, as COMMUNITY SUPERVISION WEEK in Georgia.
