## **A PROCLAMATION**

## **CONCRETE PIPE WEEK**

Such reinforced concrete pipe and precast concrete products and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of the concrete pipe and precast concrete industry, the trucking industry, the sand and rock producers, the cement producers and employees, who are responsible for designing, manufacturing, distributing, and supplying reinforced concrete pipe and precast concrete products to the owners and contractors who design, construct, and maintain our transportation and storm drainage infrastructure, and our residential and commercial subdivisions, which are so essential to our citizens; and

This week, citizens of Georgia can gain knowledge of and maintain an understanding of the importance of reinforced concrete pipe and precast concrete in their communities, that it is made of all natural materials; and

WHEREAS:

The year 2023 marks the 116th year of the American Concrete Pipe Association, which began as a means of exchanging ideas and establishing a high quality, standardized product, which the Georgia Concrete Pipe Association fully supports in both actions and deeds; now
