CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS: Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia occurs when a baby's diaphragm fails to fully

form; allowing abdominal organs into the chest cavity and preventing lung

growth; and

WHEREAS: There are many people living in Georgia who have been diagnosed with and

have survived their CDH, although many families in Georgia have endured the horrible pain and grief associated with the loss of loved ones with CDH; and

WHEREAS: Those with CDH often endure multiple surgeries and possible medical

Those with CDH often endure multiple surgeries and possible medical complications beyond their diagnosis that include heart defects, pulmonary

complications, gastric and intestinal problems, developmental delays, and may

require respiratory and medicinal support for years; and

WHEREAS: Increasing awareness about CDH can help bring more research for better

treatments and screenings; now
