A PROCLAMATION

FAMILY CHILDCARE DAY

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia recognizes the necessity of quality childcare; and

WHEREAS: Family childcare professionals in Georgia work in more than 1,200 family child learning homes serving thousands of children from birth through elementary school; and

WHEREAS: Early childhood education programs across Georgia benefit the development of both children and families by providing flexible environments dedicated to positive outcomes; and

WHEREAS: Family childcare providers offer nurturing and consistent care, develop lasting relations with families, and prepare children with the skills they need to enter school eager to learn; and

WHEREAS: Quality early learning experiences and childcare services are essential to Georgia's bright future; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 15, 2023, as FAMILY CHILDCARE DAY in Georgia.
