

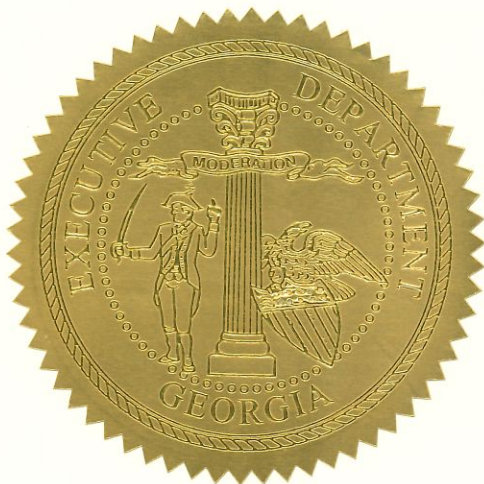

- WHEREAS:** During the celebration of Financial Planning Week, Georgia joins with FPA chapters across the country to support activities that increase public knowledge of the value of financial planning; now
