A PROCLAMATION

GEORGIA CUP DAY

- WHEREAS:** Mr. Sam Bennett of Madisonville, Texas and Texas A&M University, while displaying great golfing skill, courage, and sportsmanship, won the United States Amateur Championship in 2022; and
- WHEREAS:** Mr. Aldrich Potgieter of Mossel Bay, South Africa, while displaying great golfing skill, courage, and sportsmanship, won the British Amateur Championship in 2022; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia has a long and illustrious history of distinguished golf champions, both professional and amateur; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia is home to a proud golf history, hosting premier events such as the Masters and the PGA Tour Championship and serving as the home of legendary pros such as Bobby Jones; and
- WHEREAS:** The Golf Club of Georgia has organized a competition between the United States and British Amateur Golf Champions known as The Georgia Cup; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Cup has provided a unique golf competition for 26 years and is a charitable fundraising event benefiting Folds of Honor; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Cup is a celebration of championship amateur golf and the honor, integrity, sportsmanship, and civility displayed by those competitors who have played with such distinction; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 26, 2023, as GEORGIA CUP DAY in Georgia.
