A PROCLAMATION

GEORGIA PARALEGAL WEEK

WHEREAS:

Paralegals are professionals qualified through education, training, or work experience to perform substantive legal work which requires proficient knowledge of legal concepts that are customarily, but not exclusively, performed by a lawyer; and

WHEREAS:

Working under the guidance of an attorney, paralegals improve the management of cases, contribute substantially to the quality of legal services throughout the State of Georgia, and reduce legal costs to the public; and

WHEREAS:

Excellence, dedication, and integrity are the noteworthy characteristics of paralegals, and those in Georgia uphold the highest standards of professionalism; and

WHEREAS:

The observance of Paralegal Week provides an opportunity for Georgians to recognize paralegals throughout the state for their efforts to help our legal system perform at an important level of efficiency; now

THEREFORE:

I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim June 11 - 17, 2023 as PARALEGAL WEEK in Georgia.
