- WHEREAS:** Nonprofits of all sizes provide crucial services, ensure their communities continue to thrive, and improve peoples' lives in countless ways, whether it's through medical treatment, after school activities, educational training, a day at a park, a theatrical performance, or providing food, clothing, or rental and utility assistance; and
- WHEREAS:** As the season of giving commences, it's crucial to recognize the need to give to the nonprofits that sustain our community and all the benefits that we receive from them; and
- WHEREAS:** Since its inception in 2012, GA Gives on GivingTuesday has broken its record each year for the amount of funds raised for Georgia nonprofits, showcasing the impact of its day and the true generosity of Georgians; and
- WHEREAS:** GA Gives on GivingTuesday is increasingly impactful in providing Georgia nonprofits with additional funding necessary to further their impact; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim November 28th, 2023, as GIVING TUESDAY in Georgia.
