A PROCLAMATION

INTERNATIONAL CREDIT UNION DAY

- WHEREAS:** Credit unions are profit financial cooperatives, which are owned, operated, and founded by people coming together in unity towards economic advancement; and
- WHEREAS:** Credit unions uphold a people-helping-people ideology through the gathering of resources and leadership capabilities for the purposes of encouraging members to improve their own financial lives and helping those in need; and
- WHEREAS:** Over 85,000 credit unions have helped people empower themselves and improve their communities internationally; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia is pleased to recognize the credit union community for its contributions to the financial well-being of its members and for the contributions credit unions make to the communities of the state of Georgia; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 19th, 2023, as INTERNATIONAL CREDIT UNION DAY in Georgia.
