## LISSENCEPHALY AWARENESS DAY

WHEREAS:	Lissencephaly is a rare gene-linked brain malformation, causing the brain to have less or no ridges & folds – making it appear smooth; and
WHEREAS:	People living with this condition may also suffer from hypertonia, epilepsy, swallowing disorders, developmental delays, and more; and
WHEREAS:	Addressing these complex medical needs early in life is imperative to helping families successfully care for their children at home. Further awareness of this condition is imperative to providing needed community education and support for families; and
WHEREAS:	Organizations such as the Lissencephaly Foundation Inc provide much needed support to individuals suffering from this condition, empowering their families, and educating communities: and
WHEREAS:	The State of Georgia encourages its citizens, patients, caregivers, medical professionals, and organizations to learn more about this condition and to spread awareness in order to improve treatment options; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim September 8, 2023, as LISSENCEPHALY AWARENESS DAY in Georgia.
