- WHEREAS:** I encourage all Georgians to join me in celebrating the past, present, and future contributions and advancements of these talented women as HERstory; and
- WHEREAS:** We must share their HERstory and empower the next generation of unconventional women leaders while honoring their gifts to our great state; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 29, 2023, as MAKING HERSTORY DAY in Georgia.
