A PROCLAMATION

MUNICIPAL COURT CLERKS WEEK

- WHEREAS:** Municipal courts play a significant role in providing access to justice, preserving public safety, and promoting quality of life in Georgia; and
- WHEREAS:** More people encounter municipal court clerks than all other Georgia court personnel and the public impression of the entire Georgia judicial system is largely dependent upon the public's experience with municipal courts; and
- WHEREAS:** Municipal Court Clerks have pledged to be ever mindful of their neutrality and impartiality, rendering equal service to all, and conforming to the standards set by the Uniform Rules for Municipal Courts of the State of Georgia; and
- WHEREAS:** It is most appropriate that we recognize the Municipal Court Clerks that represent the over 380 Georgia Municipal Courts and the critical role they play; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia recognizes the positive impact municipal court clerks have had on its citizens and quality of life; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim June 5-9, 2023, as MUNICIPAL COURT CLERKS WEEK in Georgia.
