- **WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia is the proud home of many highly skilled aviation technicians as they support the high volume of traffic at Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport and the Delta Air Lines headquarters; and
- **WHEREAS:** AMTs consist of one of the aviation industry's top talents, possessing sought-after skills such as avionics, welding, engine overhaul, composites, engineering, and more, as the need for their expertise continues to grow; and

**WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia recognizes National AMT Day, the contributions of these important airline professionals, and the need to shine a continued spotlight on these important aviation careers now and in the future; now
