A PROCLAMATION

WINDOW FILM DAY

WHEREAS:	Nearly 80 percent of all Window Film in the world is manufactured in the United States by leading companies and offers significant economic benefits at all levels; and
WHEREAS:	Window Film presents many benefits to both consumers and businesses, helping them to save money on their energy bills and reduce peak demand for electricity when utilities are most challenged; and
WHEREAS:	National Window Film Day is a day to recognize the citizens who manufacture, distribute, and install Window Film and those who work to promote the benefits of Window Film; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 30, 2023, as WINDOW FILM DAY in Georgia.
