A PROCLAMATION

PROCUREMENT MONTH

WHEREAS: The procurement of goods and services within the private and public sectors throughout the State of Georgia and the United States as a whole is pivotal to the success of our economy; and

WHEREAS:Since purchasing has such a great influence on the state's economy through the
monitoring of management of billion dollars of goods and services, it is important to
ensure that there are competitive, fair, open, and transparent procurement processes
to aid in obtaining the best value for every taxpayer dollar; and

WHEREAS: Not only are purchasing professionals securing goods and services to fulfill their organization's needs, but they are also adding value to the organization by negotiating, implementing, and managing contracts; developing and implementing professional training and outreach strategies; and building relationships with the supplier community, as well as partnerships focused on the improvement of all sizes of businesses; and

WHEREAS: When urgent and unprecedented challenges arise, and there is a need to secure materials and resources in an urgent, safe, and secure manner, government purchasing professionals work diligently to meet these demands; thus, contributing to stable and prosperous communities throughout Georgia; and

WHEREAS: During the month of March, the Georgia Department of Administrative Services, Georgia Chapter of the National Institute of Governmental Purchasing (NIGP), Governmental Procurement Association of Georgia, and the Coastal Georgia Chapter of NIGP, along with other professional procurement organizations in our state, participate in raising awareness of the importance of purchasing professionals in the fields of business, industry, and government; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 2023, as PROCUREMENT MONTH in Georgia.
