- WHEREAS:** Comprehensive school counseling programs are considered an integral part of the educational process that enables all students to achieve success in school; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim February 6-10, 2023, as SCHOOL COUNSELING WEEK in Georgia.
