## **APROCLAMATION**

## **SCHOOL NURSE DAY**

students have a right to an education, despite any medical issues that require attention while at school, and school nurses are uniquely qualified to provide a critical safety net

for students; and

WHEREAS: School nurses provide care to medically fragile students, as well as students who have

acute illnesses and injuries; and

WHEREAS: Families deserve to feel confident that their children are always protected and cared

for while in school, by a licensed and qualified school nurse who is an integral part of

the educational setting; and

WHEREAS: School nurses consistently address student, staff, and parental concerns for safety

daily, acting as a liaison to the school community, parents, and health care providers;

and

WHEREAS: Students are the future and helping them achieve takes many team members, and the

school nurse plays an important role as a member of the educational team; now

WHEREAS: School nurses promote health and wellness in the student population to instill healthy

habits that will provide a healthier future for the community; and

WHEREAS: School nurses have served in a critical role to ensure the physical and mental wellbeing

and safety of staff while maximizing the educational success of students; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 10,

2023, as SCHOOL NURSE DAY in Georgia.
