## **A PROCLAMATION**

## **TENNIS MONTH**

WHEREAS:	The United States Tennis Association (USTA), the Georgia Tennis Association (USTA Georgia), and the Georgia Tennis Foundation promote the play and growth of the sport of tennis in Georgia at every age, ability, and level of play from beginners to touring professionals; and
WHEREAS:	Playing tennis at any ability level improves heart health, agility, and can provide a positive and fun environment to spend time with family and friends while staying active; and
WHEREAS:	By increasing accessibility of tennis for Georgians of all ages and ability, USTA Georgia and the Georgia Tennis Foundation have helped make Georgia communities healthier; and
WHEREAS:	USTA has declared the month of May as National Tennis Month to encourage players, organizations, facilities, retailers, tennis manufacturers, and many other tennis providers to promote local programs and activities at public parks and facilities, private clubs, schools, colleges, and universities to showcase tennis and spread the word about the sport and its benefits, and to help players and non-players alike find courts and play opportunities in their communities; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 2023, as TENNIS MONTH in Georgia.
