A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend an Act to provide a new charter for the City of Comer, approved May 1, 2002 (Ga.
L. 2002, p. 5306), so as to increase the term of mayor from two to four years; to revise
provisions relating to municipal elections to address changes to the mayoral term of office;
to provide for the continuance in office of the current mayor and councilmembers; to provide
for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7	SECTION 1.
8	An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Comer, approved May 1, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002,
9	p. 5306), is amended by revising Section 2.28 as follows:
10	"SECTION 2.28.
11	Election of mayor; forfeiture; compensation.
12	The mayor shall be elected and, as of January 1, 2024, shall serve for a term of four years and
13	until the mayor's successor is elected and qualified. The mayor shall be a qualified elector

14 of this city and shall have been a resident of the city for six months prior to the election. The

15 mayor shall continue to reside in this city during the period of the mayor's service. The 16 mayor shall forfeit the office of mayor on the same grounds and under the same procedure 17 as for councilmembers. The compensation of the mayor shall be established in the same 18 manner as for councilmembers."

19	SECTION 2.
20	Said Act is further amended by revising Section 5.11 as follows:
21	"SECTION 5.11
22	Regular elections; time for holding.
23	(a) Municipal general elections shall be held on the Tuesday next following the first
24	Monday in November of each odd-numbered year. The mayor and each councilmember
25	shall serve terms of four years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified.
26	(b) At the municipal election held in 2023, there shall be elected a mayor and
27	councilmembers for Posts 2 and 3 to serve terms beginning on January 1, 2024, and ending
28	on December 31, 2027.
29	(c) At the municipal election held in 2025, there shall be elected councilmembers for
30	Posts 1 and 4 to serve terms beginning on January 1, 2026, and ending on
31	December 31, 2029."

The mayor and councilmembers serving as such on the effective date of this Act shall continue to serve as such officers until the regular expiration of the respective terms to which such officers were elected and until the election and qualification of their respective successors.
