## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 10 of Chapter 21 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the Georgia Driver's Education Commission, so as to provide for an additional
- 3 penalty for violation of traffic laws or ordinances under "Joshua's Law"; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 5 and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 10 of Chapter 21 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 the Georgia Driver's Education Commission, is amended by adding a new Code section to

- 12 (a) In each case in which a court in this state imposes a fine or bond payment, which shall
- be construed to include costs, for a violation of the traffic laws of this state or for violations
- of an ordinance of any political subdivisions that have adopted by reference the traffic laws
- of this state, there shall be imposed as an additional penalty a sum equal to 3 percent of the
- original fine.

(b) The additional penalty sum provided for in subsection (a) of this Code section shall be
 in addition to any amount required to be paid into any pension, annuity, or retirement fund
 under Title 47 or any other law of this state and in addition to any other amounts provided
 for in this article."

- or after such date.

SECTION 3.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
