A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to health, so as to 2 repeal a requirement that every ambulance service pay an annual license fee; to repeal a 3 requirement that ambulance service annual license fees be deposited into the Indigent Care 4 Trust Fund; to provide for a conforming change; to provide for related matters; to provide 5 for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7	SECTION 1.
8	Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to health, is amended by revising
9	Code Section 31-8-159, relating to reporting requirements for the Indigent Care Trust Fund,
10	as follows:
11	″31-8-159.
12	(a) The department shall annually report to the General Assembly on its use of trust funds
13	appropriated to the department pursuant to this article.
14	(b) The department shall also provide an annual report no later than September 30 of each
15	year which shall provide the following information for the immediately preceding fiscal
16	year:

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17	(1) The amount of ambulance service license fees received by the department pursuant
18	to Code Section 31-11-31.1;
19	(2) The amount of federal funds received as matching funds to the corresponding
20	ambulance service license fees received; and

- 21 (3) The total amount of funds disbursed to emergency ambulance services from the
- 22 Indigent Care Trust Fund.
- 23 The report required by this subsection shall be made available to the public free of charge
- 24 by electronic means and in such other manner as the department deems appropriate."
