8 Part 7 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
9 relating to HOPE scholarships and grants, is amended by revising division (27)(A)(i) of Code
10 Section 20-3-519, relating to definitions, as follows:

11 "(i) Having graduated from an eligible high school with a grade point average of at 12 least 3.7 calculated in accordance with Code Section 20-2-157 and having received 13 a score of at least 1,200 on the combined critical reading and math portions on a 14 single administration of the SAT administered prior to March 1, 2016, or on the total 15 score on a single administration of the SAT administered on or after March 1, 2016, 16 or an equivalent ACT composite scale score of at least 26 which shall be determined
