To amend an Act providing for a Board of Commissioners for the County of Elbert, approved
February 27, 1875 (Ga. L. 1875, p. 253), as amended, particularly by an Act approved
May 5, 2005 (Ga. L. 2005, p. 3731), so as to revise provisions relating to filling vacancies
on said board; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

An Act providing for a Board of Commissioners for the County of Elbert, approved
February 27, 1875 (Ga. L. 1875, p. 253), as amended, particularly by an Act approved
May 5, 2005 (Ga. L. 2005, p. 3731), is amended by revising subsection (a) of Section 1B as
follows:
"(a)(1) In case of a vacancy in the office of commissioner other than that of chairperson,

other than due to the expiration of a term of office, and there are six months or less in the unexpired term, the board shall elect a qualified resident of that commissioner district to serve the reminder of the unexpired term and until a successor is duly elected and qualified. 17 (2) In case of a vacancy in the office of commissioner other than that of chairperson,
18 other than due to the expiration of a term of office, and there are more than six months
19 in the unexpired term, it shall be the duty of the board of commissioners to instruct the
20 election superintendent of Elbert County to call and conduct a special election in the
21 district in which such vacancy occurred to elect a person to serve out the remainder of the
22 unexpired term and until a successor is duly elected and qualified.

(3) In case of a vacancy in the office of chairperson, other than due to the expiration of
a term of office, and there are six months or less in the unexpired term, the board shall
elect a qualified resident of the county to serve the reminder of the unexpired term and
until a successor is duly elected and qualified.

(4) In case of a vacancy in the office of chairperson, other than due to the expiration of
a term of office, and there are more than six months in the unexpired term, it shall be the
duty of the board of commissioners to instruct the election superintendent of Elbert
County to call and conduct a county-wide special election to elect a person to serve out
the remainder of the unexpired term and until a successor is duly elected and qualified."
