EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN SPALDING COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

- **WHEREAS:** Sergeant Marc Andrew McIntyre, 55, with the Spalding County Sheriff's Office was killed in the line of duty on Friday, December 29, 2023; and
- **WHEREAS:** Sergeant McIntyre was a veteran of the U.S. Army, and served with the Spalding County Sheriff's Office for eleven years; and
- **WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize Sergeant McIntyre's service to Spalding County, the State of Georgia, and the United States of America by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Spalding County to half-staff.

Now, therefore, in honor of and as a mark of respect for the memory of Sergeant Marc Andrew McIntyre, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the state of Georgia, it is hereby

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Spalding County on Friday, January 5, 2024, the day of Sergeant McIntyre's interment, until sunset.
