EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN COWETA COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

- **WHEREAS:** Deputy Eric Anthony Minix, 31, with the Coweta County Sheriff's Office was killed in the line of duty on Thursday, January 4, 2024; and
- **WHEREAS:** Deputy Minix served as a dedicated investigator and K-9 handler for the Coweta County Sheriff's Office; and
- **WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize Deputy Minix's service to Coweta County and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Coweta County to half-staff.

Now, therefore, in honor of and as a mark of respect for the memory of Deputy Eric Anthony Minix, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the state of Georgia, it is hereby

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Coweta County on Monday, January 8, 2024, the day of Deputy Minix's interment, until sunset.
