## EXECUTIVE ORDER

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

### FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING, IN FULTON AND GWINNETT COUNTIES, AND AT ALL DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE STATE OF GEORGIA ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

- WHEREAS: Trooper Jimmy Cenescar with the Georgia State Patrol was killed in the line of duty on Sunday, January 28, 2024; and
- **WHEREAS:** Trooper Cenescar honorably served with the Atlanta Police Department before joining the Georgia Department of Public Safety in January 2023 and graduating with the 114<sup>th</sup> Trooper School; and
- **WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize Trooper Cenescar's service to the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building, in Fulton and Gwinnett Counties, and at all Department of Public Safety locations throughout the State of Georgia to half-staff.

#### Now, therefore, in honor of and as a mark of respect for the memory of Trooper Jimmy Cenescar, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the state of Georgia, it is hereby

**ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building, in Fulton and Gwinnett Counties, and at all Department of Public Safety locations throughout the State of Georgia on Friday, February 9, 2024, the day of Trooper Cenescar's interment, until sunset.
