EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON ALL STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS: Sergeant Breonna Alexsondria Moffett, 23, of Savannah, Georgia,

honorably served our country in the United States Army Reserve; and

WHEREAS: Sergeant Moffett and two other soldiers were tragically killed in a drone

attack at a base in Jordan on January 28, 2024; and

WHEREAS: Sergeant Moffett enlisted in the U.S. Army Reserve in 2019 as a Horizontal

Construction Engineer; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize the sacrifices made by Sergeant Moffett

by lowering the flags on all State buildings and grounds to half-staff.

Now, therefore, in honor and as a mark of respect for the memory of Sergeant Breonna Alexsondria Moffett, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of

GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

Ordered: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be

flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds on Saturday, February

17, 2024, the day of Sergeant Moffett's funeral.
