EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON ALL STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

- WHEREAS:** Sergeant Breonna Alexsondria Moffett, 23, of Savannah, Georgia, honorably served our country in the United States Army Reserve; and
- WHEREAS:** Sergeant Moffett and two other soldiers were tragically killed in a drone attack at a base in Jordan on January 28, 2024; and
- WHEREAS:** Sergeant Moffett enlisted in the U.S. Army Reserve in 2019 as a Horizontal Construction Engineer; and
- WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to recognize the sacrifices made by Sergeant Moffett by lowering the flags on all State buildings and grounds to half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF SERGEANT BREONNA ALEXSONDRIA MOFFETT, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds on Saturday, February 17, 2024, the day of Sergeant Moffett's funeral.
