EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On March 11, 2024, Mr. Brandon Holt, Mayor of Pineview, Georgia, was

indicted on multiple felony counts of Theft by Taking; and

WHEREAS: A certified copy of the indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant

to Code Section 45-5-6(b), and received on March 13, 2024;

WHEREAS: The fourteen-day period following receipt of the indictment as prescribed

by Code Section 45-5-6(e) has passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS

HEREBY

ORDERED: That Attorney General Chris Carr, Mayor Lester Miller of Macon-Bibb, and

Mayor LaRhonda Patrick of Warner Robins are hereby appointed as the review commission to determine whether the above-mentioned indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of duties by Mayor Holt such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby, and to make a written report to me within fourteen (14) days with a recommendation as to whether Mayor Holt should be suspended from

office as required by Code Section 45-5-6(c).
