EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On March 11, 2024, Mr. Brandon Holt, Mayor of Pineview, Georgia, was indicted on multiple felony counts of Theft by Taking; and

WHEREAS: A certified copy of the indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6(b), and was received on March 13, 2024; and

WHEREAS: An Executive Order was issued on March 28, 2024, appointing members to the Review Commission to determine whether the indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of the Office of the Mayor of Pineview such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected; and

WHEREAS: By report dated April 4, 2024, the Review Commission found that the indictment of Mr. Brandon Holt does relate to and does adversely affect the administration of the Office of the Mayor of Pineview, and that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby; and recommended that Mayor Holt be suspended from office pursuant to the provisions of Code Section 45-5-6.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6 AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Mr. Brandon Holt is hereby suspended from office immediately and without further action pending the final disposition of the case or until expiration of his term of office, whichever occurs first, as provided in Code Section 45-5-6(c).
