EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 2.9 acres of improved real property

> (hereinafter the "Property") in Franklin County, Georgia filed with the State Properties Commission Real Property Record as Property BLLIP ID# 004431; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Forestry Commission and is commonly

known as the Franklin County Unit; and

WHEREAS: The Property is improved with a structure identified as "Foresters' Office" (BLLIP

ID# 36163), (hereinafter, the "Structure"), as shown in the aerial photograph

attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

The Georgia Forestry Commission vacated the Structure in 2019 and repairs were WHEREAS:

deemed cost prohibitive to maintain a structurally sound facility due to moisture

issues; and

WHEREAS: By resolution dated February 7, 2022, the Board of Commissioners of the Georgia

Forestry Commission requested authority to demolish the Structure.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: The Georgia Forestry Commission is authorized and directed to provide for the

> razing, demolition, and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia, in accordance with applicable laws, policies, and procedures, including any requirements under O.C.G.A.

§ 12-3-55 regarding historic properties that may pertain to the Structure.
