## EXECUTIVE ORDER

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: During the 2024 legislative session, the Georgia General Assembly passed

House Bill 1267 which provides, in part, that the Georgia State-wide Business Court assignment for administrative purposes shall be transferred from the Court of Appeals to the Administrative Office of the Courts; and

WHEREAS: House Bill 916, the Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2025, enacted as Act

Number 709, provides for appropriations for the Georgia State-wide

Business Court through the Court of Appeals.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Code Section 45-12-73 and the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Georgia, it is

**HEREBY** 

**Ordered:** That effective July 1, 2024, the Governor's Office of Planning and Budget shall approve any budgetary amendments submitted by the Court of Appeals or Administrative Office of the Courts to reflect the State-wide

Appeals or Administrative Office of the Courts to reflect the State-wide Business Court as an agency attached for administrative purposes only to the Judicial Council, consistent with Code Section 15-5A-16, as amended by

House Bill 1267, enacted as Act Number 601.
