EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On June 3, 2024, Mr. Elvis Davis, a member of the Dodge County Board of Education, was indicted on two counts of Child Molestation and two counts of Sexual Contact by a Foster Parent in the first degree; and

WHEREAS: A certified copy of the indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6(b), and received on June 6, 2024; and

WHEREAS: The fourteen-day period following receipt of the indictment as prescribed by Code Section 45-5-6(e) has passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Attorney General Christopher Carr, Ms. Pamela Brown of the Rockdale County Board of Education, and Mr. David Chastain of the Cobb County Board of Education are hereby appointed as the review commission to determine whether the above-mentioned indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of duties by Mr. Davis such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby, and to make a written report to me within fourteen days with a recommendation as to whether Mr. Davis should be suspended from office as required by Code Section 45-5-6(c).
