EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exist at Albany State University, Dougherty County, Albany, Georgia, buildings known as Wiley Hall, Gibson Hall, Simmons (RHS), and the ROTC/Military Science Building, (collectively, the “Buildings”), located at 504 College Drive; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents, at its meeting on June 14, 2024, declared that said Buildings could no longer be advantageously used by Albany State University or the University System of Georgia and should be removed.

NOW, THEREFORE BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Buildings from Albany State University, Dougherty County, Albany, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of Albany State University, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, are hereby authorized to demolish the Buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
