EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exists at Columbus State University, Muscogee County,

Columbus, Georgia, a building known as Woodall Hall (the "Building"),

located at 4225 University Avenue; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents, at its meeting on June 14, 2024, declared that said

Building could no longer be advantageously used by Columbus State University or the University System of Georgia and should be removed.

Now, therefore, by the power vested in me as Governor of the

STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby

authorized to demolish and remove the Building from Columbus State

University, Muscogee County, Columbus, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

Ordered: That the appropriate staff of Columbus State University, acting under the

approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, are hereby authorized to demolish the Building and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said

demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
