EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exist at Valdosta State University, Lowndes County,

Valdosta, Georgia, buildings known as 1526 N. Oak Street, 1504 N. Oak Street, 304 Baytree Road, 1506 N. Oak Street, and Parking Control Office (collectively, the "Buildings"), located at 1500 N. Patterson Street; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents, at its meeting on June 14, 2024, declared that said

Buildings could no longer be advantageously used by Valdosta State University or the University System of Georgia and should be removed.

Now, therefore, by the power vested in me as Governor of the

STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

Ordered: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby

authorized to demolish and remove the Buildings from Valdosta State

University, Lowndes County, Valdosta, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of Valdosta State University, acting under the

approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, are hereby authorized to demolish the Buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
