EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On June 11, 2024, Mr. Marcello Banes, Chairman of the Newton County

Board of Commissioners, was indicted by the United States Attorney for the Northern District of Georgia on one count of Money Laundering Conspiracy, three counts of Transactional Money Laundering, one count of Concealment Money Laundering, and one count of False Statements to a

Federal Agent; and

WHEREAS: A certified copy of the indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant

to Code Section 45-5-6(b), and received on July 9, 2024; and

WHEREAS: The fourteen-day period following receipt of the indictment as prescribed

by Code Section 45-5-6(e) has passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS

HEREBY

ORDERED: That Attorney General Christopher Carr, Clinton Johnson of the Dougherty

County Board of Commissioners, and Bruce Henry of the Jasper County Board of Commissioners are hereby appointed as the review commission to determine whether the above-mentioned indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of duties by Mr. Banes such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby, and to make a written report to me within fourteen days with a recommendation as to whether Mr. Banes should be suspended from office as required by Code

Section 45-5-6(c).
