## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** On June 18, 2024, Ms. Stephanie Woodard, Solicitor General of Hall County, was indicted by the Attorney General of Georgia on thirteen counts of False Statements and Writings and eleven counts of Theft by Taking; and

**WHEREAS:** On July 12, 2024, pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6(b), an Executive Order was issued appointing members to a review commission charged with determining whether the above-mentioned indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of duties by Ms. Woodard such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby; and

**WHEREAS:** Code Section 45-5-6(c) provides that additional time may be granted by the Governor for a review commission to make its written report; and

**WHEREAS:** On July 22, 2024, the review commission requested a fourteen-day extension for the commission to make its written report.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That the time period for the above-mentioned review commission to make its written report is extended to August 9, 2024.
