EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

EXTENDING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR TROPICAL DEPRESSION 4

PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 38-3-51, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED:

That the State of Emergency for Tropical Depression 4 declared on August 3, 2024, by Executive Order No. 08.03.24.01, and extended by Executive Order No. 08.07.24.01, which is set to expire on August 15, 2024, at 11:59 P.M., is hereby extended for five (5) days and shall expire on Tuesday, August 20, 2024, at 11:59 P.M., unless it is otherwise renewed by the Governor.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED:

That the following provisions of the State of Emergency for Tropical Depression 4 shall not be extended and shall expire on August 15, 2024, at 11:59 P.M.:

- (1) The suspension of the federal rules and regulations limiting hours that operators of commercial vehicles may drive pursuant to Part 395 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations; and
- (2) The increase of weight, height, and length restrictions for vehicles traveling through the State of Georgia for the purposes of providing relief related to this State of Emergency.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED:

That the Authorization for the Georgia National Guard to provide up to two thousand (2,000) Georgia National Guard troops to assist with the preparation, response, and recovery efforts associated with this State of Emergency for Tropical Depression 4 pursuant to Executive Order No. 08.05.24.01 shall not be extended and shall expire on August 15, 2024, at 11:59 P.M.

IT IS FURTHER

Order Shall be effective upon signature.
