EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN CARROLL COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: Investigator Taylor Jaimeson Bristow, 30, a deputy and investigator for the Carroll County Sheriff's Office, on Friday, August 23, 2024, succumbed to injuries received in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS: Investigator Bristow had served with the Carroll County Sheriff's Office for six years; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Investigator Bristow's service to Carroll County and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Carroll County to half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF INVESTIGATOR TAYLOR JAIMESON BRISTOW, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Carroll County on Thursday, August 29, 2024, the day of Investigator Bristow's funeral services, until sunset.
