EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN GREENE AND MORGAN COUNTIES ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: Battalion Chief Chris Eddy with the Greene County Fire Rescue Department

was killed in the line of duty on Wednesday, September 4, 2024; and

WHEREAS: Chief Eddy began his service with the Greene County Fire Rescue

Department in 2019 as a firefighter; and

WHEREAS: Prior to his service with the Greene County Fire Rescue, Chief Eddy was

dedicated to firefighting by serving as a volunteer with the Woodville Volunteer Fire Department and Fire Station 4 in Buckhead, as a part-time firefighter in Morgan County, and as a paid firefighter with the Putnam County Fire Department and the Old Salem Fire Rescue Department; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Chief Eddy's service to Greene County

and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building

and in Greene and Morgan Counties to half-staff.

Now, therefore, in honor of and as a mark of respect for the memory of Battalion Chief Chris Eddy, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the state of Georgia, it is

HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be

flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Greene and Morgan Counties on Sunday, September 8, 2024, the day of Battalion Chief Eddy's

interment, until sunset.
