EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On August 14, 2024, Mr. Benjamin Cary Cranford, Jr., Mayor of Thomson,

Georgia, was indicted on one count of Furnishing Prohibited Items to Inmates and

one count of Criminal Attempt to Commit a Felony; and

WHEREAS: The indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to Code Section

45-5-6(b), and the certified copy was received on August 20, 2024; and

WHEREAS: An Executive Order was issued on September 9, 2024, appointing members to the

Review Commission to determine whether the indictment relates to and adversely

affects the administration of duties by Mayor Cranford; and

WHEREAS: Additional time was granted for the Review Commission to make its written report

pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6(c); and

WHEREAS: By report received October 1, 2024, the Review Commission found that the

indictment of Mr. Benjamin Cary Cranford, Jr. does relate to and does adversely affect the administration of duties by Mayor Cranford, and that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby; and recommended that Mr. Benjamin Cary Cranford, Jr. be suspended from office pursuant to the provisions

of Code Section 45-5-6.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6, and the

AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS

HEREBY

ORDERED: That Mr. Benjamin Cary Cranford, Jr. is hereby suspended from office immediately

and without further action pending the final disposition of the case or until the expiration of his term of office, whichever occurs first, as provided in Code Section

45-5-6(c).
