A PROCLAMATION

AIRLINE DISPATCHER DAY

- WHEREAS:** The United States Civil Air Regulations went into effect on November 1, 1937, establishing the Airline Dispatcher rating; and
- WHEREAS:** Airline dispatchers assist in the planning of flight paths considering aircraft performance and loading, en route winds, thunderstorm and turbulence forecasts, airspace restrictions, and airport conditions; and
- WHEREAS:** The operational control exercised by airline dispatchers plays a critical role in aviation safety and ensures that aviation continues to be the safest mode of transportation; and
- WHEREAS:** Georgia is home to the world's busiest airport and a large global air carrier employing over 500 aircraft dispatchers; and
- WHEREAS:** November 1, 2024, has been designated as Airline Dispatchers Day to recognize the vital role of airline dispatchers in the aviation industry; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim November 1, 2024, as AIRLINE DISPATCHER DAY in Georgia.
